The \$5.5 billion Landside Access Modernization Program (LAMP) provides extensive vehicular and non-vehicular system enhancements to help improve traffic conditions in the local area and better manage airport traffic. In addition to an Automated People Mover (APM) train system, a Consolidated Rent-A-Car (ConRAC) facility and Intermodal Transportation Facilities (ITF). Improvements to, and along roadways include:
