Given that he was engaged and planning to start a family, he knew he needed something life changing.

Marquiese graduated in 2019 from the 5th HireLAX class. He went to work for LINXS on the Automated People Mover (APM), where he ended up spending the first three years of his apprenticeship. Impressively completing his apprenticeship in 3 years and 4 months, Marquise became a Journeyman Carpenter in 2022.

"I have more control of my life. As long as I control my money and do the job right, I can give my kids the life I want. This career gives me the ability to go to family reunions and take vacations. I'm starting to think about starting my own business." Marquiese is now married with three kids and now has the ability to purchase a home.
