LAX Fly Quieter Program Overview

A public education and recognition program designed to:

- Increase airport/pilot awareness of community noise concerns and adhere with noise abatement procedures and restrictions at LAX
- Encourage and acknowledge airlines for flying as quietly as possible
- Evaluate airlines on their performance and publicly acknowledge those that perform the best

Fly Quieter Program Scoring Elements



5 Primary Elements

1. **Quietest Arrivals:** based on measured noise levels from 2 monitors in residential communities
2. **Quietest Fleet:** based on certificated noise levels of aircraft operating at LAX
3. **Pilot-Initiated Early Turns:** based on the number of pilot-initiated early turns flying over communities
4. **Nighttime Non-Conforming East Departures:** based on the number of non-conforming east departures during 12 AM and 6:30 AM
5. **Restricted Nighttime Engine Run-Ups:** based on compliance with the maintenance engine run-up restrictions between 11 pm and 6 am

2 Bonus Elements

1. **Noise Reduction Efforts:** implementing any equipment, technology, or procedural type effort to reduce aircraft noise
2. **Stakeholder Engagement Efforts:** implementing outreach and educational efforts with various stakeholders

LAWA RECOGNIZES WINNERS OF 2023 LAX FLY QUIETER PROGRAM FOR EFFORTS TO REDUCE AIRCRAFT NOISE

Today Los Angeles World Airports (LAWA) recognized nine airlines operating at Los Angeles International Airport (LAX) as part of the LAX Fly Quieter program at today's special meeting of the Los Angeles Board of Airport Commissioners. The program recognizes efforts to reduce aircraft noise through voluntary operational and technical measures, as well as community engagement.

The LAX Fly Quieter program provides Los Angeles World Airports (LAWA), our airline partners and other stakeholders the opportunity to work together to reduce noise impact on our surrounding communities, and David Beck, Deputy Executive Director for Mobility, Planning and Strategic LAX, "These efforts are essential to ensuring safe, efficient and responsive airport operations, and reaffirm LAX's commitment to environmental stewardship and being good neighbors. Congratulations to the 2023 winners for the exceptional work they are doing to help make the skies quieter."

Airline operations identified as either a disruption or verified by all airlines at LAX are listed in accordance with the scoring elements:

- Aircraft noise levels as measured by metrics in residential communities.
- Hours of non-compliance with noise abatement procedures as reported by the Federal Aviation Administration.
- The number of non-compliance events by aircraft during nighttime hours between midnight and 5:00 a.m.
- Compliance with the 60/50 regulations (maximum noise level for aircraft operations is 60 db and 50 db).

The LAX Fly Quieter Program is the only major noise mitigation program in the nation that allows airports to award additional incentives for voluntarily using the latest in flighting technology on aircraft and engaging with neighboring communities and stakeholders, such as participating in the LAXCommunityVoice Dashboard.
