LAX FlyAway will launch new service from Irvine on November 16 to make travel to LAX more convenient, direct, and affordable for Orange County residents and visitors. The non-stop bus service will offer six daily trips in each direction with one-way fare \$25 for adults and free for up to two students in grades eight and under with each paying adult. Daily Rates Increase for Economy Parking Lots B and C on November 19
Economy parking lots B and C will increase from \$8 and \$10 per day, respectively, to \$10 and \$12 per day effective November 19. Both lots will continue to offer free parking for the first two hours and charge \$1 for every two hours up to the daily maximum. Free shuttle bus service 24 hours a day, seven days a week will continue to be offered between the two parking lots and LAX’s passenger terminal area.
