
## **Premium Lounges**

- → Better base building systems




- → One World Lounge will be located on the fifth floor of both the new section of Bradley West as well as the existing fifth floor of TBIT.


Most of the TBIT Airlines have started the process of implementing their lounges. The business terms for each of the lounges are pending with LAWA and should be available from LAWA within the next two months.


