Terminal 2 Program Update

Although it may take a long time to start a construction project, once it begins there is no mistaking it. The Terminal 2 airlines have seen barricades installed, removed, and re-installed in new locations to facilitate the demolition work, terrazzo installation as well as utility upgrades.

This changing environment is the new normal for Terminal 2 and is scheduled to continue for the next 18 months. Jetway Express and Wolfgang Puck's patio have been demolished, the Flight Information Display System (FIDS) relocated and overhead work to replace the mechanical, electrical, plumbing and fire/life safety systems resulted in the removal of over half the arrivals level ceiling. Construction activities scheduled for the month of June include:

- → Boarding Relocation of the Departures Level Information Desk
- → Closing of I Love LA & Partial Closing of Duty Free
- → Installation of Temporary Concession at Gate 28
- → Plumbing and Electrical Relocation in the FIS Ceiling
- → Arrivals Level Mailbox Relocation
