#### TERMINAL 4: SOUTH CONCOURSE OPENED

The south portion of the Terminal 4 Concourse has re-opened to the public as part of American Airlines' Terminal 4/5 Modernization Program. New airline gates and holdrooms are operational, as well as new concessions including The Market (south concourse) and a temporary Starbucks location (central concourse). The south concourse also features upgraded restrooms, access to Bus Gates, and artwork installed throughout.

#### TERMINAL 4: AIRLINE GATES 47A & 47B CLOSED

Airline Gates 47A & 47B are closed to facilitate construction activities related to the next phase of work for the American Airlines T4/5 Modernization Program. 

## BELLANCA AVE AT 98TH ST: LANE RESTRICTIONS

To facilitate pavement restoration by the Roadway & Utility Enabling (RUE) Project, lane restrictions will be in place at the intersection of Bellanca Ave and 98th St beginning Friday, November 1 at 9PM continuous through Monday, November 4 at 6AM.

Lanes on the west side of Bellanca Ave will be restricted, with no through movement allowed from 98th St to Bellanca Ave. North / south movement along Bellanca Ave will be maintained at all times, as well as local business access down 98th St.

Please watch for posted signage and always use caution when traveling near construction areas.


## **TERMINAL 4: PEDESTRIAN BRIDGE REMOVED**

The old Pedestrian Bridge between Terminal 4 and Parking Structure 4 has been successfully demolished and removed from the Central Terminal Area as part of the Automated People Mover Project. Guests and employees will continue to be detoured appropriately to reach / travel between upper levels of both Terminal 4 and Parking Structure 4.

## #5 OCTOBER 2024: 24/7 CTA LANE RESTRICTIONS

The map below is a collective snapshot of all scheduled 24/7 lane restrictions for CTA Departures and Arrivals Level Roadways for the month of October 2024.

### **PLEASE** NOTE:

This map only reflects 24/7 continuous lane closures in the CTA: other nightly lane closures / sidewalk restrictions may be in place to facilitate construction activities.

## **ACCESS** MAINTAINED:

Traffic around the Central Terminal Area will be maintained at all times, as well as access to passenger pick-up and drop-off.
