#1 AUTOMATED PEOPLE MOVER CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

It has been announced that LAX's Automated People Mover (APM) is anticipated to begin service to passengers in January 2026, with construction activities scheduled for completion by December 8, 2025.

The LAX APM will operate 24/7 with trains arriving every 2 minutes during peak travel times. It will provide access to all terminals, parking structures, rideshare options, the LAX Rental Car Center, Metro's LAX Metro Transit Center, and more!

Gates 47A & 47B

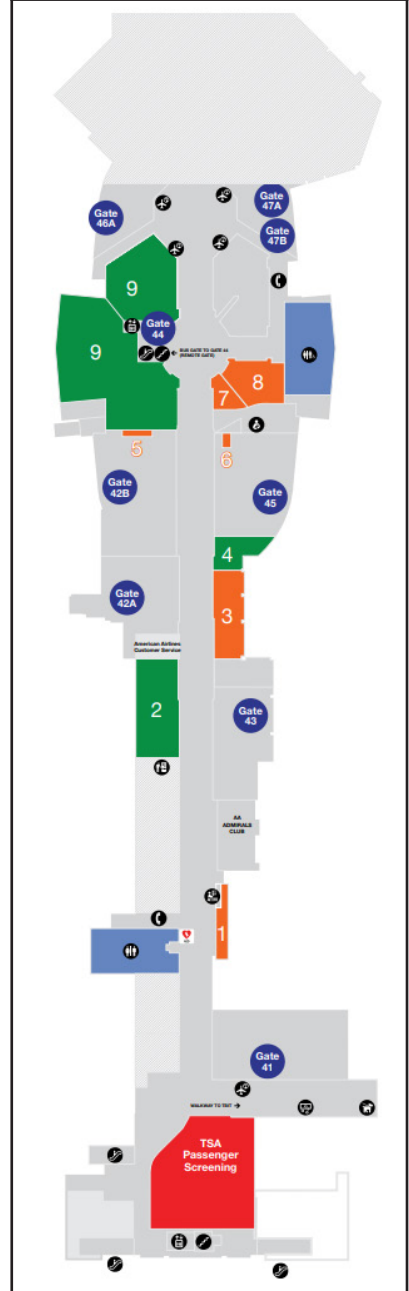
Projected re-opening: January 2025

This map only reflects 24/7 continuous lane closures in the CTA; other nightly lane closures / sidewalk restrictions may be in place to facilitate construction activities.

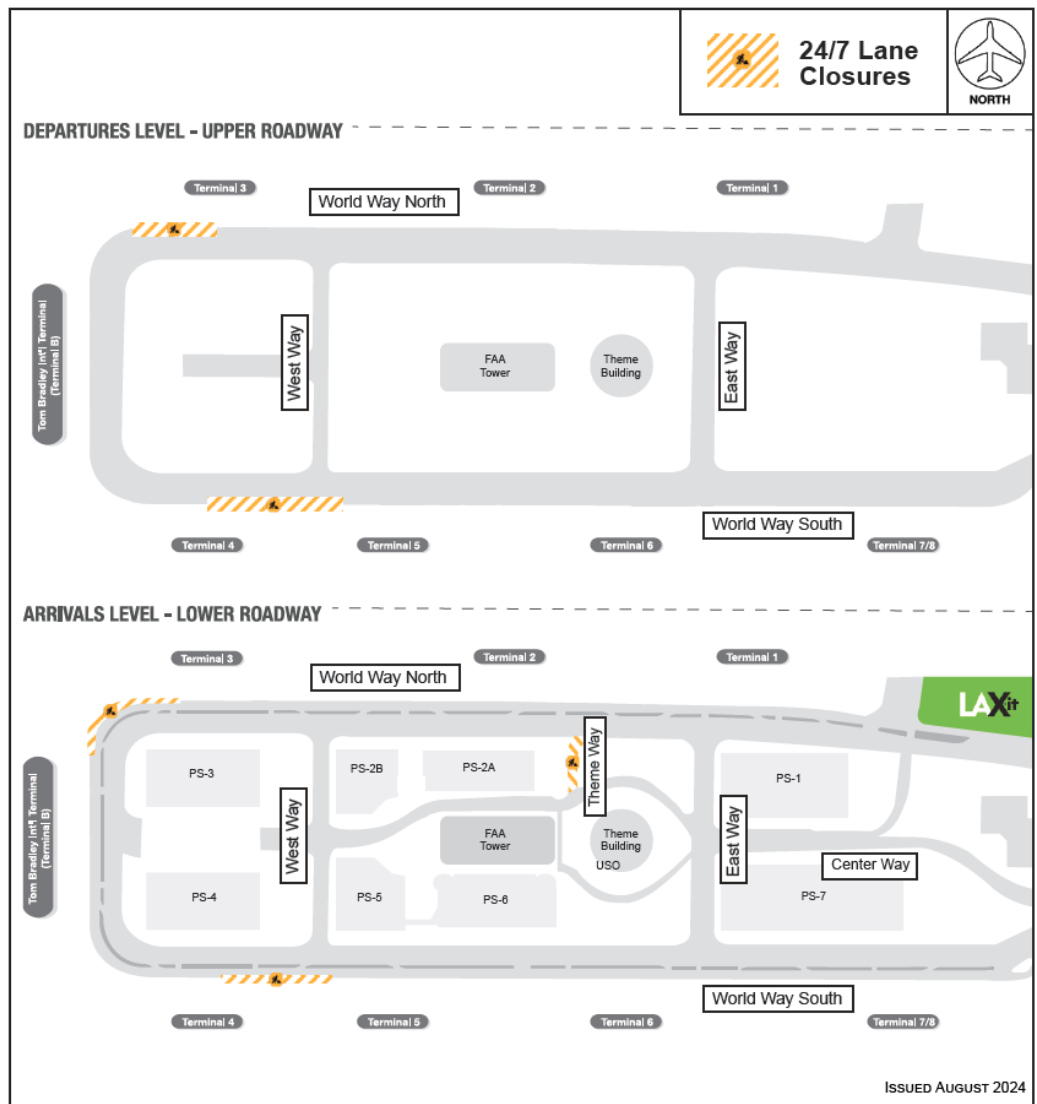
ACCESS MAINTAINED:
